ORDER**PER LT GEN GAUTAM MOORTHY, MEMBER (ADMINISTRATIVE)**

1. This case has been filed Under Section 14 of Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for Fixation of Pay in the rank of Hony Nb Sub who retired as Havildar. The applicant was enrolled in the Indian Army on 06 December, 1997 as Store Hand Technical under AOC Records, Secunderabad and was discharged from the Army on 31.12.2003 after having rendered 26 years and 26 days of colour service in the rank of Havildar. On the occasion of Republic Day on 26th January, 2004, he was awarded the Hony rank of Nb Sub. Till date no monetary benefit has been granted to him despite his approach to the OIC Records and PCDA (P), Allahabad.

2. The issue of grant of pension in the rank of Hony Nb Sub to the personnel who were discharged as Havildar is no longer res-integra. In view of the catena of judgements, Govt of India, Ministry of Defence, Department of Ex-servicemen Welfare, D (Pension/Legal) letter vide F. No. 3(8)/2013/D (Pensions/Legal) dated 30th October, 2017 also extended this benefit with regard to the pension of Hony Nb Sub to those Havildars who were discharged pre 2006, from 01.01.2006 onwards.

3. Hence, there is no requirement of calling for the Respondents to file any Affidavit-in-Opposition.

4. The applicant is entitled to the revised pension w.e.f. 01.01.2006. Therefore, his pension is to be revised by the Respondents within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of this order, failing which a simple interest @ 8% per annum to be paid to the applicant till the date of realization.

5. It is also made clear that an amount of Rs. 100/- per month which was already paid to the applicant in terms of Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence letter dt. 06.11.1991 shall be adjusted against the amount due to the applicant as per this order and the said amount of Rs. 100/- per month as paid shall be discontinued.
6. Accordingly, the application is allowed with the directions as above.
7. No order as to costs.
8. A plain copy of this order, duly countersigned by the Tribunal Officer, be furnished to both the sides after observance of all usual formalities.
