Souvik Nandy, ld. adv. appears on behalf of the respondents. We
have heard Id. advocates for both sides.
As per compliance report filed by Mr. Souvik Nandy, ld. adv.
for the respondents, we find that the prayer of the applicant
with regard to full pension and other related pensionary
benefits, as has been made in para 8(i) of the OA, has been fully
met and no further grievance exists in this regard. Mr. Basu, ld.
adv. for the applicant has also confirmed that the applicant is in
receipt of his pension. So far as prayer made in para 8(ii) is
concerned, it has already been complied with by the
respondents.
As regards the prayer made in para 8(iii), we find that such
prayer is not entertainable since it is not within the competence
of this Tribunal to direct initiation of prosecution against the
persons who have not even been named in the OA.
So far as prayer for cost is concerned, considering the facts
and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to award any

In view of the above, the application stands partially allowed with regard to his prayer made in para 8(i) and (ii), as indicated above.
