	<p>Mr. Arup Kundu along with Mr. Dilip Kumar Maity, learned counsels appear for the applicant. Mr. Anup Kumar Biswas, learned counsel appearing for the respondents files his memo of appearance which may be kept with the record.</p> <p>Upon perusal of the application, we observe that it is a fit case for admission. Mr. Biswas raises no objection to the admission of this case. Let the matter be, therefore, admitted.</p> <p>As prayed for, the respondents are granted six weeks' time to file their affidavit-in-opposition along with the original relevant records of this case and the JAG review report including the court of inquiry, if any. Mr. Maity prays for two weeks thereafter to file the affidavit-in-reply. Such prayer stands granted.</p> <p>There is a prayer for interim order made in the OA at para 9(a) of the application. We find that the applicant has since been dismissed from service and he is no more in colour service. Therefore, the prayer for interim order made therein is infructuous and is thus rejected.</p> <p>Let the matter appear for further order on 27.01.2014.
