	<p>Mr. Subhas Chandra Basu, learned counsel appears for the applicant. Mr. Dipak Kumar Mukherjee, learned counsel appears for the respondents.</p> <p>We find from records that we had directed the respondents vide our earlier order dated 17.07.2013 to cause production of certain documents as elaborately mentioned in para 4 (a) to (d) of the ibid order. It appears that the said documents have not yet been produced. Lt. Col. Anil Chandra, OIC, Legal Cell, HQ Bengal Area submits that despite having taken steps to obtain the above documents, they have not yet received the same for which he further prays for four weeks time. Such prayer stands granted since for the sake of justice, the ibid documents are very much important for adjudication of the matter.</p> <p>However, we make it very clear that in case there is any further delay in causing production of these documents, no further extension of time will be granted.</p> <p>Let the matter appear for hearing on 26.03.2014.</p>
