	<p>Mr. K. Ramesh, Id. advocate along with Mr. S. K. Choudhury, Id. advocate appears on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Mintu Kumar Goswami, Id. advocate for the respondents is present. His memo of appearance has already been submitted and is kept with the record.</p> <p>It is a fit case to be admitted being transferred from the AFT, Lucknow Bench in accordance with order passed by the AFT, Principal Bench, New Delhi presided over by the Hon'ble Chairperson. Let it be admitted.</p> <p>Mr. Goswami, Id. counsel for the respondents prays for six weeks' time to file affidavit-in-opposition and Mr. Ramesh, Id. counsel for the applicant prays for two weeks' time thereafter to file his affidavit-in-reply.</p> <p>We are of the view that this being a case of a serving officer it requires urgent application of mind for which the respondents should take the matter with more urgency to expedite pleadings.
