	<p>Mr. Jagdish Ranjan Das, learned counsel for the applicant is not present without any intimation. Mr. Dipak Kumar Mukherjee, learned counsel appears for respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4. Mr. Mintu Kumar Goswami, learned counsel assisted by Mr. Suman Basu, Advocate appearing for respondent No. 3 submits their vakalatnama which may be kept with the record. Mr. Anirban Chowdhury, Treasury Officer, Krishnagar Treasury –I, Nadia, respondent No. 3 is also personally present.</p> <p>We find from records that the A/Os from all the respondents have already been filed. However, no A/R to these A/Os has yet been filed by the applicant. We, therefore, direct the learned counsel for the applicant to file the A/R, if advised, within three weeks from this date.</p> <p>Learned Registrar of this Bench shall communicate the gist of this order to Mr. Jagdish Ranjan Das, learned counsel for the applicant intimating the next date.</p>

We also find from records that the original documents pertinent to this case have not yet been filed by the respondents. The respondents are, therefore, directed to produce all the relevant original records in this case before the next date. At this stage, Mr. Mukherjee prays for four weeks to cause production of such documents. Such prayer stands granted.

We further direct respondent Nos. 3 and 4 that if they contemplate to take any action to provide relief to the applicant in any manner within their rules, they will be free to take such action and pendency of this case before this court will be no bar for the authorities to consider and grant such relief to the applicant.

Let the matter appear for further order on 07.11.2014.
