Mr. Biswas files memo of appearance which may be taken on record. Being dissatisfied with rejection of prayer for re-instatement, the instant application has been filed. The applicant submits that after rejection of his first appeal claiming for disability pension he went for his treatment in AIIMS Hospital, New Delhi where he has been found fit and pursuant thereto he approached the respondents for his reinstatement which has been rejected vide order dated 08.08.2015. Ld. counsel for the applicant submits that the application may be disposed of by permitting the applicant to file a fresh representation/2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal before the respondent authorities by annexing the report of the AIIMS Hospital and directing the respondents to consider the same in the light of the AIIMS Hospital report. Ld. counsel for the respondents has no objection to such prayer of the applicant. In view of the above, the applicant is permitted to file an application/2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal along with the copy of the AIIMS Hospital report to the respondent authorities within a period of fifteen days. The respondents in turn shall decide the same in accordance with law after considering the above medical report of the AIIMS Hospital and after carrying our re-medical examination, if considered necessary and shall pass a reasoned order at the earliest preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the application/2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal. With the above observation, the application is disposed of. A plain copy of the order, duly countersigned by the Tribunal Officer, be furnished to both sides after observance of usual formalities.
