The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant after completing the training period had joined the Naval service as Sailor on 14.2.2013. Counsel further submits while the applicant was undergoing on probation his services were dispensed with. Counsel for the applicant submits that there is no hearing and the order has been passed by the respondents ex-parte in violation of principle of natural justice. It is the settled proposition of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court by catena of judgments with regard to violation of principle of natural justice which may be looked into by the respondent authorities.
