	<p>Order Sl. No. : <u>13</u> Dated : <u>24.10.2013</u></p> <p>Mr. Subhash Chandra Basu, Id. adv. is present on behalf of the applicant. Mr. D.K.Mukherjee, Id. adv. is present for the respondents.</p> <p>At the outset, Mr. Mukherjee points out that his name has been wrongly typed in our order dt. 24.7.13 which may be rectified. We notice that it is a typographical error in which Mr. Mukherjee's name has been incorrectly spelt. The same be rectified by the office.</p> <p>In accordance with our order dt. 24.7.13, the respondents have submitted the documents as asked for, which may be kept on record. As prayed for by Mr. Basu, he is at liberty to inspect those documents after observing due formalities.</p> <p>On perusal of the documents produced, we find some difficulty to understand with regard to the nature of duties performed by the applicant while he was posted in various ships which need to be explained. For proper adjudication of the matter, we are of the view that a responsible officer from the Executive Branch of Navy will be able to explain these aspects properly to the court.</p>

Accordingly, we direct the respondents that a responsible officer from the Executive Branch of the local Navy office be present on the next date to explain the above aspects.

Under such circumstances, the matter is adjourned to 3.1.14.
